Directions:

M4 jctn 11 - go south to the roundabout and turn right in the direction of Mortimer. Take the second right, signed Pingewood. Follow the road through all the twists and turns for 2.7 miles. Turn right into Searles Farm Lane and the Island Sailing Club is the first gate on the right.

M4 jctn 12 - follow the A4 into Reading for 2.0 miles until you reach some traffic lights and 'The George & Dragon' pub on your left. At the lights, filter right into Burghfield Road and follow it into the country, past 'The Peter Pan' cafe. After you leave the 30 mph limit you will see a left turn signed 'Pingewood' and 'Berry's Lane'. Follow this road for about half a mile and Searles Farm Lane will be found on the left, the Island Sailing Club is the first gate on the right.

Reading - go out of Reading on the A4 until you reach 'The George & Dragon' pub. Turn left at the traffic lights into Burfield Road and follow it into the country, past 'The Peter Pan' cafe. After you leave the 30 mph limit you will see a left turn signed 'Pingewood' and 'Berry's Lane'. Follow this road for about half a mile and Searles Farm Lane will be found on the left, the Island Sailing Club is the first gate on the right.
